- CHILDREN UNDER 7 MUST BE MET BY A PARENT/GUARDIAN AT THE SNOW BOWL. PARENTS CAN ARRANGE A PRIVATE LESSON FOR THIS AGE GROUP BY CALLING THE SNOW BOWL SKI SCHOOL DIRECTLY.
- CHILDREN 7-9 ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GROUP LESSONS OFFERED BY THE SNOW BOWL. PLEASE CONTACT THE SNOW BOWL SKI SCHOOL DIRECTLY FOR AFTER SCHOOL LESSONS.
- SEASON LEASE EQUIPMENT INFORMATION IS INCLUDED. A SEASON LEASE OF EQUIPMENT SAVES YOU AND YOUR CHILD(REN) TIME BY ELIMINATING THE WEEKLY STOP AT THE RENTAL SHOP.
- THERE ARE 3 FORMS TO FILL OUT. 2 OF THE FORMS ARE A ONE TIME ONLY FORM -REGISTRATION AND RENTALS (IF NEEDED). THE LAST FORM IS THE TRANSPORTATION & PAYMENT FORM WHICH IS DUE WEEKLY.
- EACH STUDENT, INCLUDING PARENTS NEEDING LIFT TICKETS, NEEDS TO FILL OUT A WEEKLY TRANSPORTATION & PAYMENT FORM.

Lincolnville Central School 2022 After-School Ski/Snowboard Program

The Lincolnville Central School is offering an after-school Ski/Snowboard Program again in 2022. This is a great program for your children to get to the mountain and ski/snowboard. Please read over the information below as well as attached documents and return all forms, permission slips & fees to the school by **Monday**, **January 10**th for our first outing on Friday, January 14th.

2022 After School Ski/Snowboard Program Information

- The After School Ski/Snowboard Program is geared towards 2nd through 8th graders. Children below 2nd grade (under age 7) need to be accompanied by an adult family member or be met at the Snow Bowl by an adult upon our arrival.
- Children ages 7-9 are strongly encouraged to sign up for the group lesson if the parent will not be at the Snow Bowl. Sign up by contacting the Snow Bowl ski school directly. The best option for new skiers/riders is the K.A.T.S program.
- Children will ride the bus to the Snow Bowl unless the parent arranges other transportation.

PARENTS & LCS STAFF WELCOME!

This is an affordable way for parents, family members, as well as LCS Staff to come out & ski/snowboard. If you would like to take advantage of the group rates, please fill out and sign a Transportation & Payment form each week you would like to attend.

Dates & Times

The program runs on Fridays in January, February and possibly March (weather dependent). Skiers/snowboarders may attend one or as many sessions as they wish. Current planned dates are: January 14th, 21th, 28th, February 4th, 11th, 18th and possibly March 4th.

The bus will leave LCS approximately 3:15 pm and arrive at the Snow Bowl approximately 3:40 pm. The bus is ONE WAY and will NOT return to LCS.

Children will need to be picked up at the Camden Snow Bowl by a parent or other properly identified adult by 5:30 pm. Please find a chaperone in the lodge and sign your child out before leaving the Snow Bowl. If your child will be staying past 5:30 pm they will be unsupervised, and we will need a signed note stating you give your permission for them to stay (see the enclosed Transportation & Payment form). The Snow Bowl closes at 7:00pm.

Costs

Lift Ticket \$15 (required unless you have a Season Pass to the Camden Snow Bowl) Equipment Rental \$15 (optional)

Children 5 and under ski free when accompanied by a paying adult

Lessons	Equipment Rentals
Lessons Lessons must be booked directly through the Ski School office at the Snow Bowl. K.A.T.S. Group lessons (skiing or snowboarding) start at 4:00 PM and last until 5:30 PM. The price of a lesson does not include a lift ticket. Please purchase a lift ticket if your child is taking a lesson. Group lessons are only available to children 7 and older. If your child is new to skiing/snowboarding please plan on picking them up at the Snow Bowl when their lesson ends at 5:30 PM unless you intend to ski with them after the lesson.	 If ski or snowboard rental equipment is needed, a Camden Snow Bowl rental agreement form and payment must be completed and turned in on the Monday prior to the Friday ski date. The rental form only needs to be filled out once per season, but the payment form must be filled out each week your child needs rentals, with rental box checked on the payment form. If the information on the rental form is not complete, equipment may not be ready when our group arrives. The Snow Bowl cannot give out rental equipment without the proper release signatures. ♣ At the end of each session, each individual who is

	The Snow Bowl requires that a lift ticket is also purchased to rent equipment.
	Sidecountry Sports and Maine Sport offer Season lease packages. The lease allows your child to rent their
	ski/snowboards and boots for the entire season without having to turn in the equipment each time
	they use it. Your child will be able to take their equipment home with them for the entire season.

Sign Up & Paperwork

Forms, waivers & and payment for the options selected (lift ticket and rentals) are due in the school office by 3:00pm on the Monday before we ski. This needs to be done one week at a time. Other family members wishing to join us at the Snow Bowl to ski must also fill out the Transportation & Payment form for each ski session they plan to attend.

Checks should be made payable to the Camden Snowbowl.

OTHER PROGRAM INFORMATION

- Sometimes weather conditions make it necessary to cancel an evening ski session. That
 decision will be made on that day by Michelle Kinney and the bus company. If cancellation is
 needed, an announcement will be made at school, and your child will go home after school on
 his/her regular bus. Skiing is a winter sport. Be sure that your skiers are dressed appropriately
 for all weather conditions.
- Skiers meeting our group at the Snow Bowl will need to meet the chaperones in the Lodge or Rental Office after the arrival of the bus to receive lift tickets. They should not attempt to get tickets from the ticket office at the Snow Bowl.
- Participation in the Ski Program depends upon continued cooperation and good behavior at the Snow Bowl and on the bus. School rules and behavioral expectations will be followed. Any difficulty in this area will result in non-participation in the following ski sessions.
- Students who have their own ski equipment <u>cannot</u> bring it to and from school on the regular school bus. Parents will need to bring it to the school and store it in the hallway at the school. Alternatively, parents may drop equipment off at the Snow Bowl. Just remember that skis, boards and poles must be left on the racks behind the lodge. All other equipment can be stored in cubbies inside the lodge.
- A food concession is available at the ski lodge. Participants should bring money or pack a bag with food and drinks.
- Please find a chaperone in the lodge and sign your child out before leaving the Snow Bowl.
- Chaperones needed: Scheduled trips will only happen if we have at least 2 parent chaperones for each Friday (either on the slopes or in the lodge.) Please contact Michelle Kinney if you are available to chaperone.

Warning/Liability Release and Agreement Not to SUE

I have received the equipment listed on this agreement and have been instructed on its use. I verify that the personal information (height, weight, age, skier classification) on this ticket is correct. If at any time I feel the equipment is not functioning properly, I will stop using it and return it for inspection, repair or adjustments.

I understand and agree that skiing, snowboarding and other winter sports are HAZARDOUS activities, that INJURIES from various causes are an INHERENT RISK of participating in these activities, and that injuries to any or all parts of my body are a COMMON AND ORDINARY OCCURRENCE during these activities. I freely accept and ASSUME ALL RISKS OF INJURY OR DEATH that may occur while using this equipment.

ALPINE SYSTEMS: I have confirmed that the visual release indicators on the alpine ski bindings are the same as those designated on this ticket. I understand and agree that alpine ski/boot/binding systems CANNOT RELEASE OR RETAIN in all situations where release or retention may prevent injury, that they therefore CANNOT GUARANTEE MY SAFETY, and that undesired release or retention are inherent risks of skiing.

SNOWBOARDS AND X-C: I understand that the binding systems on snowboards and cross-country skis are NOT INTENDED TO RELEASRE in a fall or upon impact.

HELMETS: I understand and agree that no headgear can protect against all foreseeable impacts, that skiing and snowboarding can expose the user to forces which exceed the limits of protection offered by this helmet, that helmets do not guard against injury to the neck, spine, face or any other part of the body, and that these features are inherent risks of skiing and snowboarding. Helmets must be properly fitted to each user, and I agree that this helmet has been properly fitted by the provider. I warrant that the helmet is comfortably snug and that when I fasten the chin strap and shake my head there is no significant movement of the helmet. I agree that if the helmet is damaged or involved in any kind of accident, I will stop using it immediately, return it to the shop and report the accident or damage.

To the fullest extend allowed by law, I agree to RELEASE FROM LIABILITY, and to INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS The Rossignol Group and all other manufacturers and distributors of the equipment provided to me under this agreement, any involved winter sport area, shop or service technician, and their owners, agents, employers and employees for any injuries, damages or death related to the use of this equipment. I FURTHER AGREE NOT TO MAKE A CLAIM OR SUE FOR INJURIES OR DAMAGES RELATING TO THE USE OF THIS EQUIPMENT, whether such claim is based on NEGLICENCE, breach of warranty, product defect or any other theory. I accept this equipment AS IS with no warranties, express or implied. These waivers and obligations extend to my heirs and assigns.

THIS DOCUMENTS IS A LEGALLY BINDING CONTRACT which supersedes any other agreements or representations by or between the parties. it shall be interpreted to provide as broad and inclusive a release of liability as is legally possible, but is not intended to assert any claims or defenses which are prohibited by law. If any part of this agreement is deemed void or unenforceable, the remainder shall be given full force and effect. The specific rights of the parties under this contract may vary from state to state.

If this equipment is to be used by someone other than me, I certify that I am signing it as agent, parent or legal guardian for the user and that i will provide this form and all warnings and information to the user.
